Our approach is based on an amendable demarcation of areas within a four-indicator diagram, each of which represents a core dimension of food and nutrition security (FNS), which makes our typology conceptually sound, operationally flexible, and less data intensive. Despite a continuum of heterogeneous development challenges across the country, the typology helped identify various clusters of territories which suffer mostly from production, access, and utilization constraints.
